


Academic success is central to our philosophy. Our boys achieve well above the national expectations with Brymore placing in the top 2% of schools in the country for academic progress.

Our boys are encouraged to tend and develop the gardens, preparing themselves for the world of work through gaining academic qualifications in Horticulture and taking responsibility for the school's grounds. We encourage enterprise, creativity and flair, alongside practical experience. Boys are involved in landscaping, design and garden maintenance. They leave with skills for life.



Our market garden provides a real 'hands-on' business enterprise that fosters links with the local community. Salad and vegetables are produced for Blackmore Farm and our own farm shop. Surplus vegetables and fruit are supplied to the school kitchens and also sold to parents and staff. The gardens are also home to the Quantock Beekeepers and Brymore honey is produced and sold.

Teaching techniques and methods match industry standards and we are proud of the boys' achievement in winning a gold award in the Garden of Gardens competition. Level 5 RHS benchmarking status also recognises our commitment to sharing 'best practice'.





The boys are taught to industrial standards and have the opportunity to follow courses in welding, blacksmithing, coppersmithing, engineering, sheet metal work, motor-vehicle maintenance, computer aided design alongside traditional wood and metal work. GCSE projects have included coffee tables, working trailers, dog kennels and five bar gates.

These opportunities develop and widen the boys' practical skills and knowledge to such an extent, that many choose engineering as a career – progressing to Further Education courses and the acquisition of qualifications in engineering.

Brymore farms 110 acres of land where it grows fodder beet, rears chickens, pigs, beef and lambs and produces milk. Friesan Holstein, Ayrshire and Jersey cows are all part of the dairy herd averaging 6,000 litres of milk a year which is sold through Dairy Crest. Calves are bred from the farm's pedigree Beef Shorthorn Bull, Adrian – one of our best-loved residents.

Brymore boys enjoy the 'hands on' experience of a working farm under the expert guidance of the Farm Manager and the true spirit of enterprise sees the Farm Shop selling the meat and eggs that are produced.

Boys also complete duties at the Cannington Centre of Bridgwater College where they gain experience of a state-of-the-art mechanised milking parlour.
