- Following feedback from students who attended activities week last year, we have added alternative provision

  The alternative provision will vary slightly day to day, as students who attend will have time to complete art,
  photography and media studies activities. If your son wishes to attend the alternative provision he can speak with
  Mrs Blake and book himself on to the activity.

In order to enable your child to participate in activities week please complete the consent form\* and payment slip indicating your chosen method of payment and return to the finance office by Friday 15 June 2018. The cost this year will be £73. We would like to thank FOBSA for heavily subsidising this year's activities week, allowing us to keep the costs as low as possible.
