Dear Parent/Guardian

A small plea for help please! We have noticed recently that the number of students who do not have basic stationery items is increasing; this is starting to have an impact on learning as valuable lesson time is lost making sure that everyone has the correct equipment.

Please could we ask that you support your son to be responsible and have the following non-negotiable basic equipment with him for all lessons:

- Pencil case
- A minimum of 2 black or blue pens
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Rubber
- At least one red pen
- A selection of highlighters

It would be even better if they had:

- Glue stick
- Maths set - compass, protractor etc.
- Colouring pencils
- A scientific calculator - Casio 83GTCW

As a school we will be purchasing a small stock of stationery which will be available for students to purchase. We will also have fully stocked pencil cases for sale if a student should need this option. The full price list can be found at the end of this letter.

Twice a week tutors will be checking that students have their basic equipment during tutor time. If they do not have the correct equipment, they will be encouraged to purchase any missing items from our school supply - hopefully this will help parents avoid making endless trips to the supermarket! To reinforce to the boys that it is their responsibility for being prepared for their learning as well as looking after their belongings. Please note that from week commencing 6th January 2026, should a student arrive to a lesson without any of the basic equipment they require, they will receive a level 1 for not having the correct equipment.

Our 'stationery shop' will be run by our senior students and will be accessible during tutor times, as well as selected break and lunch times. Students will be able to pay via card, their phones or by making a withdrawal from their activities account. Any stationery that cannot be paid for will be deducted from a student's initial deposit when joining.

Please may we also take this opportunity to ask that students remember to bring a reuseable water bottle which they can refill at break and lunch time, so they do not have to ask to leave lessons for a drink.
